Since we are on the subject of the lunch program, I need to let you know that there will be some price increases on the selections beginning with the February lunch order. As I mentioned on back to school night, if we did not get enough volunteers we would need to order out more frequently. We did not get a large amount of consistent volunteers so we need to order lunch out more rather than cook more lunches in the kitchen. There are days when there are just 2 people in the kitchen. Our vendors also informed us back in December that there would be an increase in our prices due to the rising costs of food in general. The cost of other items such as the condiments, plates, utensils, etc. has historically been absorbed by the lunch program. We can no

longer afford to not incorporate these costs in the menu items. We regret having to increase the prices but in order for the program to remain financially stable, we had no choice. Thank you for your understanding.

I would like to let you know that the PTG will be supplying ice cream and toppings for ice cream sundae day during Catholic Schools Week as well. We will also be sponsoring 2 assemblies in the coming months for the children.

As we look to the future, the PTG will be holding a Bingo night at the American Legion in Elmwood Park on February 20th. Keep your calendar open for a fun night. We are also going to be holding the annual Tricky Tray on May 7th at the Venetian. It is expected that every family donate a basket to this event to help make it the big success it has in the past. Notices will be going home about that in the coming weeks.
